GUEST SPEAKER

Today's guest speaker is Edward Hasbrouck, talking about the Identity Project and vaccine mandates. Member of the National Legal Guild, although a non-lawyer himself. Has worked with many libertarians inside and outside the LP. The IP founded by John Gilmore, an LP member. The IP, based in Oakland, focuses on First Amendment issues, specifically "freedom to assemble" during Covid-19 mandates. See PapersPlease.org . Being able to show vaccine status, without revealing who you are-- similar to medical marijuana ID cards; a credential with no identifying information (medical pot facilities purposefully create verifications without disclosing identification). The same can be done with Covid-19 vaccine passports. The fact that it's not being done that way suggests that the Department of Public Health is up to something else (bad faith or gross negligence?).

Martin: Jewell v. NSA since 2009. Gov using telephone companies to access everything on our phones. The telecom companies are complicit in handing over people's private information.

Jeff: Every day activism in NH. There is a bill that would allow NH to declare independence, that if the voters approve would become law/legally viable.
